What is the Sports Premium?

As part of the Olympic Legacy, the government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for the academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15 to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. Each school will receive £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil each year for two years.

Purpose of the funding

The funding must be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sports provision and must ensure that through its use that a sustainable impact can be seen.

We aim to encourage every child at Fairway Primary School to achieve their physical potential and develop their confidence to contribute to their own health and wellbeing and that of others.

Fairway have been able to offer children within our school a variety of experiences to support their engagement in sport, to compete at various levels and develop a positive attitude to a healthy lifestyle.
