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## Current

### Congestion around the school entrance

**Description**

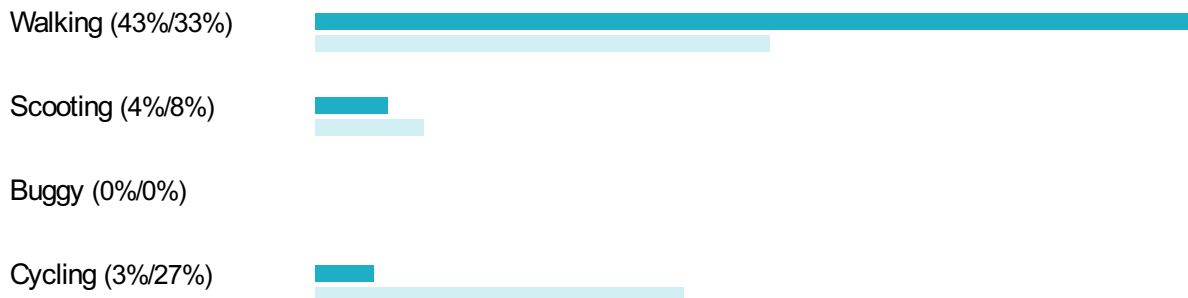

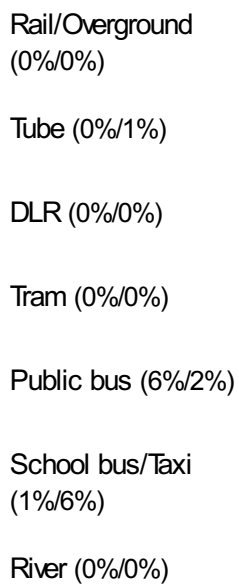

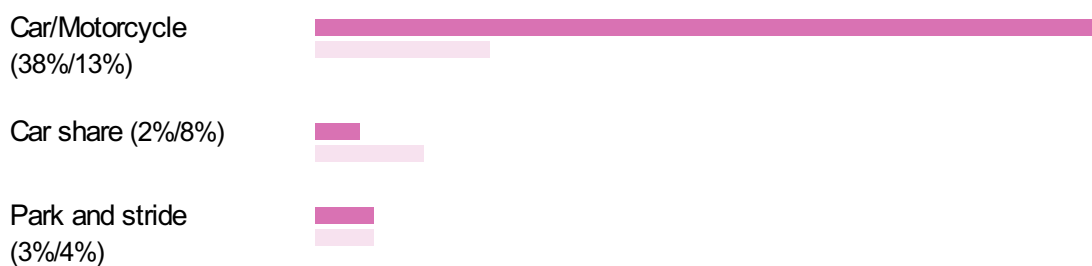
